Make your own dragon's blood

Dragon's blood is a liquid of shimmering teal and is said to hold the essence of ancient magic and untold power. A single drop can heal the gravest wounds or ignite enchantments strong enough to bend the fabric of reality.



What you'll need

Distilled water
Mica powder
Empty bottle, preferably with a cork top string
wax seal kit (optional)
dragon charm (optional)
label (on the next page)

Instructions

1. Make sure your bottle is clean and dust-free.
2. Fill the empty bottle with the distilled water until it nearly reaches the brim, leaving adequate space for the lid.
3. Add approximately 1/4 teaspoon of mica powder to achieve the desired swirling effect. Adjust the quantity if you are using a larger bottle. Add a little extra at a time.
4. Secure the lid onto the bottle and use string to wrap around the neck. Seal the ends by tying and burning them (you may need an adult to do this).
5. Attach your dragon charm securely.
6. Carefully pour your warm wax over the lid and, using a wax seal, press down on the top.
7. Apply your label, and behold! Your dragon's blood is complete!
